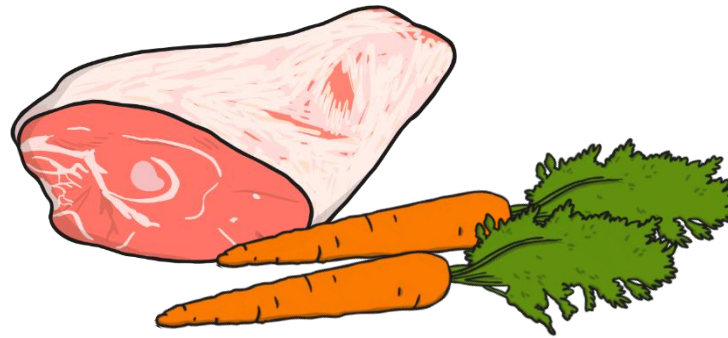


Carnivores, Herbivores and Omnivores





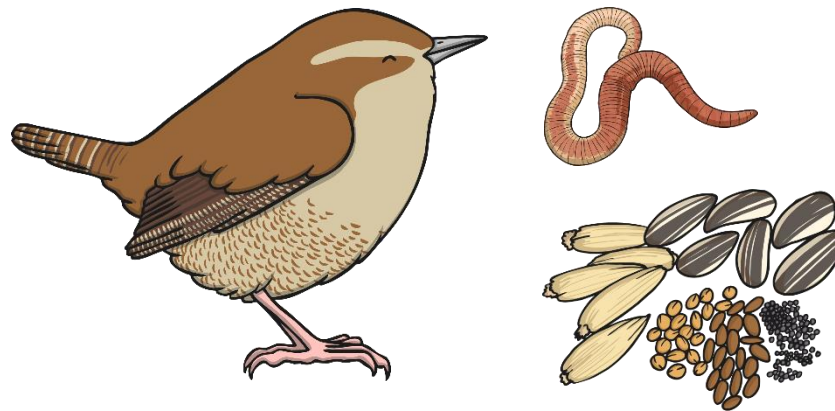
I am exploring

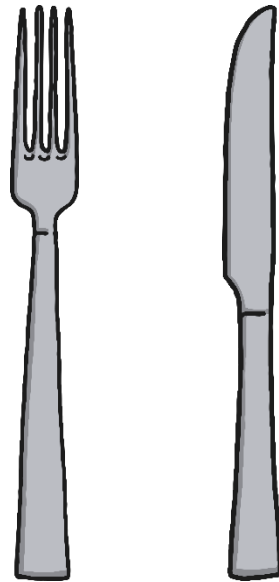
Can you draw a picture of an animal with the things

Before we look at the pictures you have drawn, let's learn something about what animals eat.



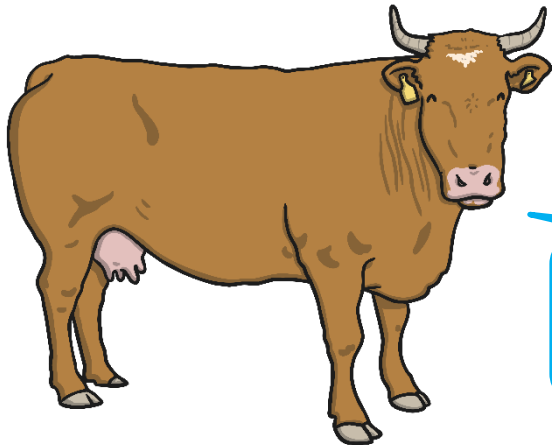


Herbivores

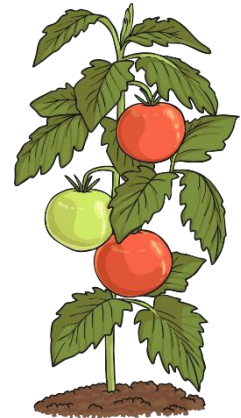
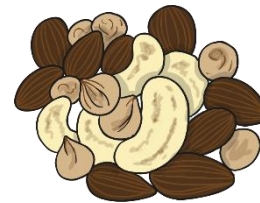
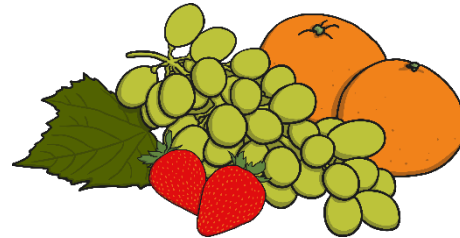


are animals that only eat plants.

You could remember the word

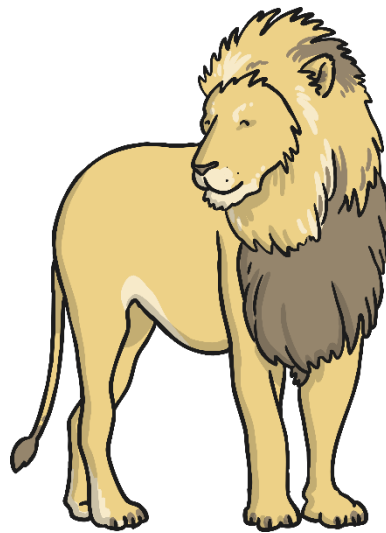
Herbivore

These are animals like chickens that can eat seeds and worms.

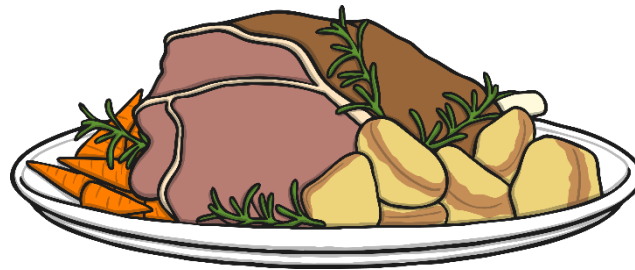

eat meat.

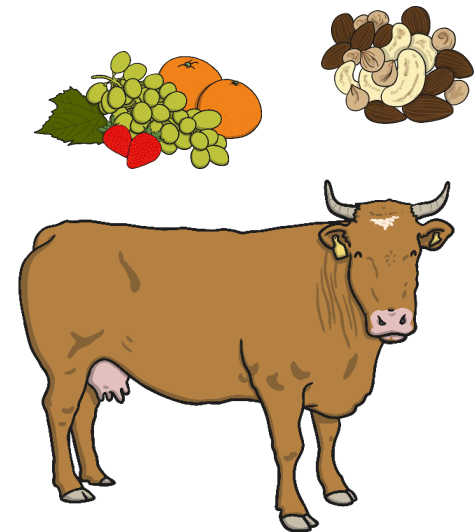
These animals have to

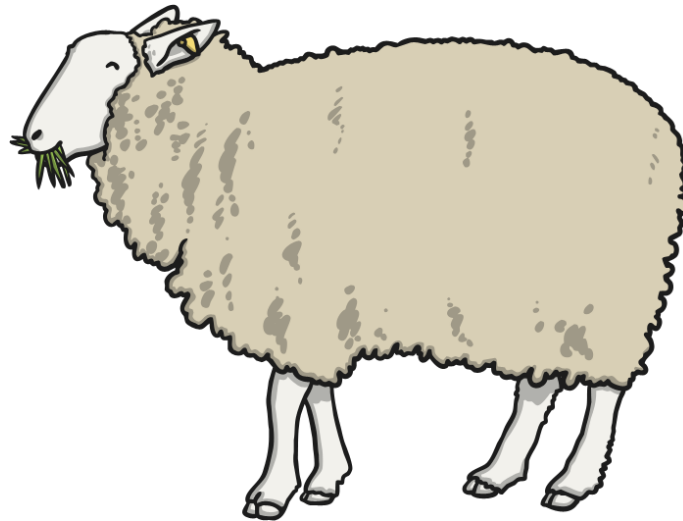

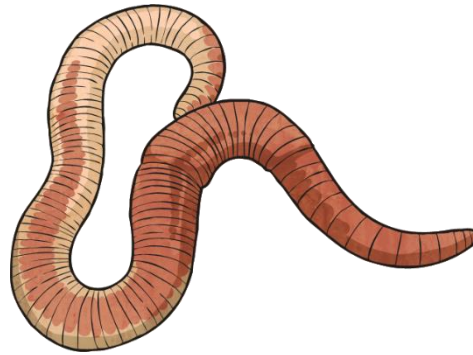
A cat eats mice.

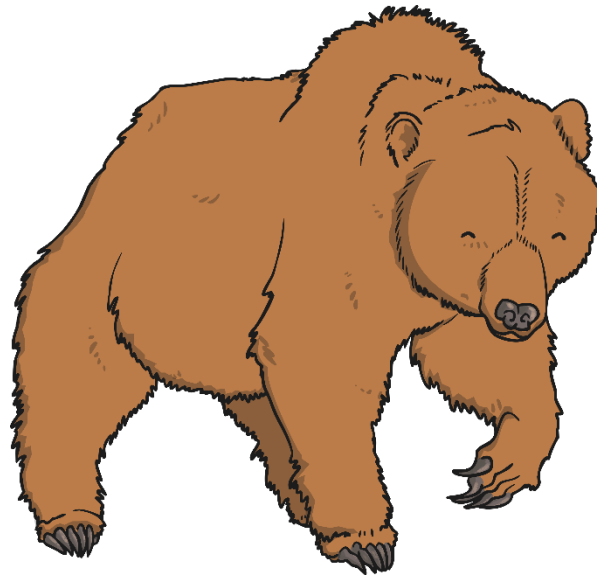
A worm eats rotten leaves and roots.
