Dear parents and carers,

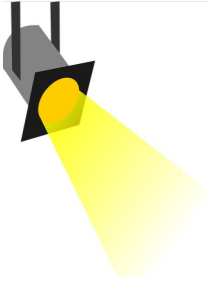

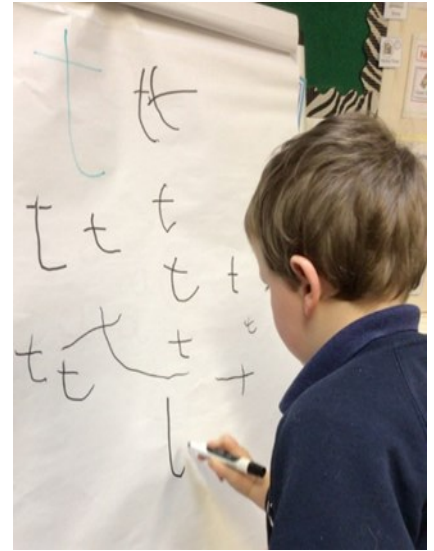

Spotlight on EYFS...



This week, the spotlight is on our **Nursery and Reception classes**.

In Nursery, we have been learning about minibeasts. The children have enjoyed finding out all about where minibeasts live as well as observing their pattern, size and colour. A minibeast hunt helped us to investigate which ones live in our nursery garden. We have also begun learning our phase 2 letter sounds during phonics, focusing on sounds, rhymes and letter shapes.



In Reception, we have had lots of fun engaging in our outdoor learning activities! We have enjoyed searching for camouflaged 'wiggly worms', going on scavenger hunts, cloud gazing and planting. We will keep a close eye on how our radishes and runner beans are growing over the next few weeks and are excited to see how they turn out!
