Dear parents and carers,

Spotlight on EYFS...




This week, the spotlight is on our Reception and Nursery classes.

In Nursery, we have been learning about creatures which live under the sea. We have explored a variety of sea life, looking more closely at their colour, patterns and habitat. We have enjoyed learning more about our Topic through the stories, 'Commotion in the Ocean', 'Sharing a Shell' and 'The Rainbow Fish'.
